
## THE IAM NATIONAL PENSION PLAN REMAINS IN CRITICAL STATUS

## MORE ABOUT THE IAM NATIONAL PENSION FUND



IAM can't guarantee Delta employees would participate — the company has to negotiate and agree. IAM-represented workers at Alaska, Southwest, and Spirit aren't in the plan.



Even if IAM could negotiate its pension plan at Delta, it would be years before any employee would see any benefits. Employees would not be eligible for benefits for at least five years — and prior service does not count.



The IAM has cut pension benefits before, resulting in 40% lower benefits than in 2010.
